Replacement of promotional photos for Eva Caridi's 'Nude' exhibition

Award-winning artist; Eva Caridi has agreed to replace the photos used to promote her forthcoming London exhibition 'Nude' due to the demands of the venue; Ambika P3 which is part of the University of Westminster.

The University has notified the team that some of the photos used to promote the exhibition are considered to be inappropriate. It is on this basis that it has been agreed not to use the photos of Eva's young niece to promote the exhibition as the team does not want the future of this important exhibition at Ambika P3 jeopardised.

Eva Caridi comments: "'Nude' is a commentary on time and the human condition where our soul is undressed of the superfluous and ephemeral. I am not the kind of artist that only externalises what I have inside without a thought for how it can be perceived. I wish to educate and encourage people to be more introspective and I do not want people to be distracted by offence to miss the vital points raised by my exhibition."

'Nude' has been a long journey involving years of study and research which has intricately and thoughtfully been constructed to be a spectacular, thought-provoking exhibition that engages users to look at themselves in the stark light of reality. 'Nude' runs from January 12 – 22, 2012 from 10am – 6pm at Ambika P3, 35 Marylebone Road, London NW1 5LS.
